

Day 01

Airport / Colombo



Arrival at Colombo International Airport, where you will be met and assisted by our representative in Sri Lanka, followed by a transfer to Colombo. Colombo is the commercial and business capital of Sri Lanka. Originally a small seaport, it rose to prominence in the 16th century with the arrival of the Portuguese in 1505, and its development as a major harbor continued under the British. Colombo became the capital of Sri Lanka in 1815 after the annexation of the Kandyan Kingdom. The city is a shopper's paradise, offering opportunities for bargains on quality clothing and fashion accessories. A visit to ODEL Unlimited allows you to indulge in designer apparel for the entire family, while also treating your taste buds to a delightful culinary experience.

Day 02

Colombo / Kandy



After breakfast at the hotel, proceed to Kandy, en route visiting a spice garden.

Explore a spice garden in Kadugannawa to discover the many spices for which Sri Lanka is renowned. The gardens are among the finest on the island, offering insights into how different spices are grown and processed. A local processing and training unit has been established, with farmers organized in a cooperative to ensure fair prices. Guests also have the opportunity to purchase fresh spices. Continue to Kandy to visit the Gem Museum, where you can learn about Sri Lanka's rich gem industry. In the evening, enjoy a vibrant Kandy Cultural Dance Show, showcasing traditional Kandyan dances and music.

Day 03

Kandy



After breakfast at the hotel, visit the Temple of the Tooth Relic in Kandy. The Temple of the Tooth Relic houses one of Sri Lanka's most sacred Buddhist relics. When King Wimaladharmasuriya I (1592–1604 A.D.) became king, he recovered the Tooth Relic, which had been hidden for over 44 years at the Delgomuwa Buddhist Temple in Kuruwita. He brought it to Kandy in a grand procession. The first temple was built next to the Royal Palace by King Wimaladharmasuriya I, but it was later destroyed by the Portuguese. Subsequent kings—Wimaladharmasuriya II (1687–1707) and Narendra Singhe (1707–1739 A.D.)—reconstructed the temple, with the current structure likely dating from King Narendra Singhe's era. The outer walls feature 32 beautifully painted Jataka Stories. Afternoon at leisure at the hotel.

Day 04

Kandy / Wadduwa



After breakfast at the hotel, proceed to Wadduwa, visiting a tea factory and tea estate en route. Giragama Tea Plantation, located in the Central Province near Kandy, spreads across many hectares. A tailor-made private tour offers an in-depth experience of all aspects of tea—from the early days of planting and colonial settler lifestyles to the manufacturing process and how flavors are crafted to suit different palates. Local expertise ensures a rich and flexible learning experience. In the afternoon, arrive at the hotel in Wadduwa. Wadduwa, on Sri Lanka's southwestern coast, is a serene beach paradise bordered by coconut plantations. Kuda Waskaduwa, where many exclusive hotels are located, is known for its golden sands and clear blue waters. The village remains a working fishing community, and a morning stroll to the local market offers a glimpse of the day's fresh catch from the Indian Ocean.

Dinner and overnight stay at Oakray Beach.



Day 05

Beruwala / Airport / Maldives



After breakfast at the hotel, proceed to Bandaranaike International Airport for your departure flight to the Maldives. Upon arrival at Malé, a Karusan Travel representative will assist with your airport transfer. From there, take a 30–40 minute speedboat ride to Maafushi Local Island and check in to your beach hotel.
